

Young Nuclea sailors on World Championship Cadet

On August 5th 2017 the official and festive opening ceremony of the World and Promotion Championships Cadet sailing 2017 was taking place in the marina of Bruinisse. During the championships the best Cadet sailors of the world were measuring their forces on the beautiful Grevelingen Lake of Zeeland.

During the World Championship 120 boats participated from all over the world. From Argentina to Australia, from Russia to England. Bruinisse was chosen because of the new marina at the Grevelingen Lake, the biggest salt water lake of Western Europe and a unique nature reserve.

The Cadet is a complete 2 man boat for children between 7 and 17 years old, equipped with a mainsail, a foresail and a spinnaker. It is an international sailing competition class for youngsters, recognized by ISAF. The steersmen are mostly a little bit older than the crew, which they train.
